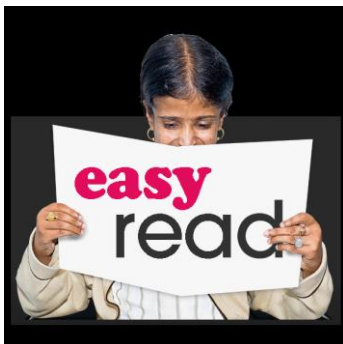

We have 6 Practice Nurses and

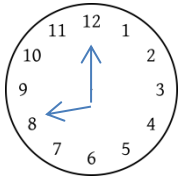

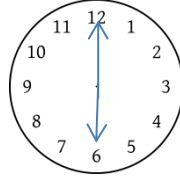

## Repeat Prescriptions

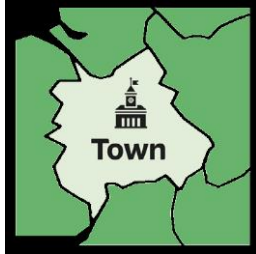


There are different 3 ways you can order your repeat medication:-
